








New Disclosure — areas to check

- Examples we are seeing








The Advice process — raising the bar

- Apply the six-step advice process
- What are your key advice documents
- Start with updated advice templates
- Record-keeping suggestions
- Give constructive feedback







Full licensing — how to prepare

- Unpick the requirements and obligations
 - What does it mean to run a licensed business?
 - Implement your new policies
 - Develop in house checks
- Technology providers and sole trader FAPs
